
Dear Friends,

Thank you for your continued support as we strive to meet a small portion of the needs of those we assist in Haiti. The challenges we face are significant, yet one remarkable observation from our years in this ministry is that the individuals we engage with are not ones to complain. They make the most of their circumstances and consistently seek to shine a positive light, praising God for His unwavering faithfulness. Their faith serves as a source of inspiration for us. Likewise, your faith inspires us as you continue to entrust us with your sacrificial gifts and prayers. We simply want to express our heartfelt gratitude—Thank You!

To keep you informed of the current situation, here are some of the updates:

- -The school in Savanette has been able to open in relative calm in the area with 65students
- Pouille school has not opened due to the in security of their area.
- -There are many displaced people from the surrounding area and fear abounds.
- -The Pouille Christian Church does continue to hold one or two services each week, although they can hear heavy detonations from the village as the fighting continues in that region.
- -Gangs continue to control large areas in Haiti.

To visualize the magnitude of the problem, Volner has shared a map of Haiti(andwhoiscontrolling it).



A Note from Volner

Dear friends in Christ. "There shall be showers of blessings" That classic hymn written in 1883 was playing while I was looking at the map of Haiti and saw the areas of the country that are sadly being controlled by the "Haiti Taliban groups". While the situation is affecting the very existence of the nation, I want to express gratitude and ask for your prayers for a few brave heroes and heroines from all walks of life who are facing danger daily while helping the people. I think about a Catholic priest and a group of parishioners who have been kidnaped on Sunday, Oct. 26. Please continue to pray and pronounce benedictions over Haiti! Some Exciting News...

You might remember that a while back, we had plans to build a dormitory for the orphaned children attending school in Savanette. Due to turmoil and challenges in acquiring supplies, that project had to be postponed. We have been holding onto the funds donated for this purpose until we could resume the work. The need is more pressing now, and since Savanette is relatively safe, we are thrilled to announce that the project is getting back on track.

Phase One involves installing a floor, adding stucco walls, and putting in a door. A temporary roof has already been placed over part of the dormitory. The estimated cost for Phase One is \$1,000, which we already have. We are grateful to move forward with this much-needed project and praise God for His provision.

Phase Two will include adding windows and a complete roof, but for now, we are delighted to make these essential improvements. If you'd like to assist with the next phase, please reach out to us.

In the past, we mentioned the need to replace a motorcycle for the caretaker at the Savanette school and home. He takes care of the day-to-day responsibilities of the school and home for the children. This includes delivering food and supplies and taking sick children to the hospital. Funds were generously donated, and the motorcycle was ordered. Coming from Brazil, It has just arrived and is already such a blessing to that community. Please pray for his safety as he often travels in dangerous areas and join us in thanking God for His provision.







One final observation...

Volner has pointed out that the full name of the school at Savanette is "College Elim de Savanette". "Elim" was an oasis in the Biblical desert where the Israelites camped after their journey from Marah (the place of bitter waters). Its twelve wells and seventy palm trees were a true oasis for them. The school at Savanette is indeed an "oasis" for the students and community. Just as the Biblical Elim was God's provision from the harsh environment for the Israelites, we are grateful for God's provision of "oasis" from the harsh surroundings for the people in Savanette. Jesus is taught there and there is no better Oasis.
